**Grades 2-12:** Classes will tour the History Center from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Lunch space is available in Heritage Square Park from 12:30 to 1 p.m.

**Specialty Tour for Grade 4:** This year, we offer a new, local alternative to visiting St. Augustine. Students split their time among the History Center (one-hour guided tour), the Orlando Public Library (one hour of guided activities including butter-making and candle-making), and a one-hour walking tour of downtown Orlando's historic sites. Lunch will be scheduled during the tour, which is from 10:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Note: Regular two-hour History Center tours are also available for 4th graders.
