Our History on the Go programs are funded through United Arts of Central Florida and Orange County Public Schools. Please complete this form so that your school may be considered for funding. Title 1 schools receive priority. Funding is allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Types of History on the Go programs

1. Teach-In programs

History Center staff teach within individual classrooms to bring history to life. The highlight of the program is the use of popular games and toys as the medium for teaching history. Through exploratory play, students learn about historical topics and make connections between past and present.

- One hour lesson per class
- Takes place in classrooms
- Serves one whole grade level
- May require multiple dates, depending on the number of classes and academic schedules

Two program themes are available:

Native Americans focuses on the Timucuan and Seminoles' way of life and their interaction and exchange with explorers and American settlers. *Recommended for Grades 2 and 4*.

Florida Statehood focuses on European explorers, countries that have controlled Florida, pioneer life, and state animals and symbols. *Recommended for Grade 4*.

2. Educational Plays and Puppet Shows

Our short plays and puppet shows focus on Central Florida history and encourage audience interaction. Shows are performed by professional actors complete with costumes and props.

- 30-45 minutes per show
- Takes place in a large performance space: cafeteria or auditorium
- Serves up to 125 students

Five show themes are available:

- 1. Habitat Hullabaloo Puppet Show, recommended for Grades K-1
- 2. Cow and Horse Puppet Show, recommended for Grades K-1
- 3. Pioneer Portraits, recommended for Grade 2 and up
- 4. Cracker Family, recommended for Grade 2 and up
- 4. First Contact: La Florida, recommended for Grade 3 and up
