Types of Guided Field Trips for Schools

Expanded for Grades K-1 (2.5 hours): Classes visit the History Center (one-hour tour) and the Orlando Public Library (an hour of guided activities). Time: 10:30 a.m. – 1 p.m. (which includes time for lunch). Cost: \$7 per student (minimum of 10). One chaperone free per 10 students; \$5 per additional chaperone. Note: Two-hour History Center tours are also available for Grades K-1 (see below).

Grades K-12: Classes tour the History Center with a docent from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Lunch space is available in Heritage Square Park from 12:30 to 1 p.m. Cost: \$7 per student (minimum of 10 students). One chaperone free per 10 students; \$5 per additional chaperone.

Specialty Tour for Grade 4: This year we offer a new, local alternative to visiting St. Augustine. Students visit the History Center (one-hour guided tour) and the Orlando Public Library (one hour of guided activities including butter- and candle-making) and take an hour-long guided walking tour of downtown Orlando historic sites. Time: 10:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.; lunch is scheduled during the tour. Cost: \$15 per student (minimum of 10). One chaperone free per 10 students; \$5 per additional chaperone. Note: Regular two-hour History Center tours are also available for 4th graders (see above).
