Standards

Prep

1. Browse through the photographs in the links below. School house images can be used for kindergarten-2nd grade. Timucuan and Seminole images are geared towards 2nd grade.


2. Print copies of the Primary Source Analysis worksheet, one per student.

Directions

- 1. Explain what a primary source is. Provide some examples. Let students know the images they are going to look at are primary sources. For 2nd grade, discuss secondary sources.
- 2. As a class, examine the photographs in the links. Read the title and the date of the photograph so students can begin to put the photographs into context.
- 3. Discuss the images. Sample questions may include: What is happening in this photo? Who do you think they are? How are they similar to you? How are they different from you? What do you think life was like back then and why? How are the Timucuan Native Americans and the Seminole Indians similar? How are they different?
- 4. Select a photograph for the students to fully examine. Go over the details provided on the website such as year and biographical notes. Students will complete the Photo Analysis worksheet.



Directions


- 1. Use before lesson to determine the range of knowledge.



"Ipad" Worksheet


