


2018 SUMMER CAMP THEMES



WEEK 1 (JUNE 4 – 8) EXPLORER LIFE

What do Native Americans, Spanish conquistadors, pirates, and astronauts have in common? They're all explorers! Join us for a fun-filled week as we find out what these voyaging people were looking for and if they found it!

WEEK 2 (JUNE 11 – 15) OH, NATURALE!

How did people and animals survive in the Sunshine State before air conditioning and bug spray? Learn about the habitats and environments of Florida, discover how the Native Americans and pioneers adapted to the harsh terrain, and practice a few survival techniques in this hands-on camp!

WEEK 3 (JUNE 18 – 22) FLORIDA FOLK ART

Channel your inner Picasso as we go back in time to examine art from various indigenous cultures and learn the fascinating history behind Florida's Hall of Fame artists. Get crafty as we recreate Seminole patchwork, design sculptures, and much more!

WEEK 4 (JUNE 25 – 29) ORDER IN THE COURT!

Guilty or innocent – you decide! Learn how our judicial system works by writing and performing your own mock trial in our museum's historic 1927 courtroom. Meet a lawyer, pat a police horse, and learn about some of Central Florida's mischievous characters. This camp is sure to bail you out from a boring summer!


some sandals – it's going to be a vacation to remember!
