Our History on the Go programs are funded through United Arts of Central Florida and Orange County Public Schools. Please complete this form so that your school may be considered for funding. Title 1 schools receive priority. Funding is allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Types of History on the Go programs

1. Teach-In programs

History Center staff teach within individual classrooms to bring history to life. The highlights of the program are STEM based activities and the use of popular toys as the medium for teaching history. Through exploratory play, students learn about historical topics and make connections between past and present.

- One hour lesson per class
- Takes place in classrooms
- Serves one whole grade level
- May require multiple dates, depending on the number of classes and academic schedules Two

program themes are available:

Native Americans focuses on comparing and contrasting Florida's indigenous people and the Native American groups throughout the United States, including Florida tribes such as the Timucua and Seminoles. Also covers the interaction and exchange with European explorers. Includes a take-home craft. *Recommended for Grades 2 and 4*.

Fighting for Florida focuses on European explorers, countries that have fought to control Florida, pioneer life, and the Seminole Wars. *Recommended for Grade 4*.

2. Plays and Puppet Shows

Our short plays and puppet shows focus on Central Florida history and encourage audience interaction. Shows are performed by professional actors complete with costumes and props.

- 30-45 minutes per show
- Takes place in a large performance space: cafeteria orauditorium
- Serves up to 125 students

Four show themes are available:

- 1. Cow and Horse Pioneer Puppet Show, recommended for Pre-K through Grade 1
- 2. Traveling Trailblazers (available Spring 2019), recommended for Grade 2 and up
- 3. Cracker Family, recommended for Grade 2 and up
- 4. First Contact: La Florida, recommended for Grade 3 and up
