For the past fifteen years, the Historical Society of Central Florida has recognized the outstanding achievements of select community members by bestowing the John Young History Maker Award upon a Central Floridian whose lifetime of achievement has made a historic impact on the community.

The John Young History Maker Award was named after our hometown hero, Captain John Young, who was the ninth person to walk on the moon as Commander of the Apollo 16 mission in 1972.

**HISTORY MAKER (PRESENT)**  
**Mable Butler**

The Honorable Mable Butler was the first African American woman to serve on Orlando's City Council (1984-1990) and the first African American member of the Orange County Board of Commissioners, where she represented District 6 (1990-1998). In her earlier public service, she worked tirelessly as director of a multipurpose center under the auspices of the Orange County Community Action Agency and was instrumental in getting the Meals on Wheels program established in much of west Orange County. Mable Butler Avenue and the Mable Butler Family Center are named in her honor.

**HISTORY MAKER (PAST)**  
**Joel Strack**

Joel Strack, who died in 2019 at 59, was a trailblazer for the LGBTQ community in Orlando. Strack co-founded the Orlando Gay Chorus and helped launch Orlando's pride parade and Disney's Gay Days. He also served on the board of directors for the LGBTQ+ Center of Orlando on Mills Avenue. "If you are gay and in Orlando, you can thank him for being able to wear your red shirts at Disney, the pride parade, Orlando Gay Chorus and the LGBTQ History Museum," George Wallace, the center's executive director, noted after Strack's death. "He was always on the front line. ... He literally put his whole life into making Orlando better."
