

As stated in your scouting book, you as the scout are responsible for the research and answers for the requirements to earn this badge. The point of this online course is to guide you through the questions and prepare yourself for the workshop. Your Merit Badge counselor will facilitate the workshop in a way that allows for you and your fellow scouts to reflect on the answers provided.

Unlike other workshops we offer, this course **MUST** be completed to attend. This course does **NOT** fall under our normal refund policy. If a cancellation is requested within 7 days of the scheduled workshop, and the course has not been completed, no refund will be offered. If a refund is requested outside of the 7 days, our normal refund policy applies.

IN THIS COURSE YOU WILL:

- Explain how the terms in requirement 1 relate to the Scout Oath and Scout Law.
- Show understanding of leadership by providing an example.
- Show understanding of ethical decision-making by providing examples.
- Show understanding of stereotyping and the harm it can cause.
- Respond to scenario questions based on skills you have learned so far.
- Speak about your experiences with your own identity and identities of others' that have been different from yours.
- Record your interview of a individual in your community.

DURING THE COURSE:

- You will be expected to research and provide sources for the requirements found in the Requirement handbook. The handbook is available in the course for reference. Throughout the course there will be specific spots and questions to help you gauge your understanding of the topics. You are **NOT** being graded on this, the amount you write or your grammar will not be checked. This course is to provide you a place to collect all your thoughts, and come to the workshop prepared to leave with your badge.
